SUBJECT: Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination and Vaccination Status of Civilian Employees

Mandatory COVID-19 vaccination of DAF personnel with Food and Drug Administration (FDA) licensed or authorized for emergency use COVID-19 vaccine reduces potential national security risks resulting from a degraded workforce. All DAF civilian employees must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 no later than November 22, 2021, unless the employee has been granted an exemption required by law, or has an exemption request pending, in those limited circumstances where the employee is legally entitled to an accommodation based on disability or sincerely held religious beliefs (reference (d)).

The DAF will obtain civilian vaccination status via the DD Form 3175 and accompanying vaccination documents as proof of their status. All DAF civilian employees (regardless of whether they are authorized to telework or perform remote work), must attest to their vaccination status by completing Section A of the DD Form 3175 "Civilian Employee Certification of Vaccination.

Additional DAF guidance regarding the attestation, screening testing, vaccination verification, and other associated impacts for civilian personnel are included in the updated DAF Mandatory COVID-19 VaccinationGuide attached.
